Topic: God's Speed

Key Verse: I Kings 18:46

Then the hand of the Lord came upon Elijah; and he girded up his loins and ran ahead of Ahab to the

entrance of Jezreel.

Welcome to our month of God's speed, divine acceleration and divine elevation!

I see a month where the **Holy Spirit takes over our natural capacity** and makes us achieve the impossible and give us victory like never before.

I see a month that is calling us into **urgent prayer for those that are traveling**, both physically and spiritually. Spiritual traveling means in the realms of prayer and other spiritual activities. Physical traveling refers to for example taking public transports or driving our own personal vehicles.

We should cover them all in prayer, and also specially those that will be traveling from different parts of the world to the Hour of Encounter prayer conference.

God's speed will help us this season to bypass limitation, overtake delays, and accomplish in one month what normally might take us years to do.

The Lord recently reminded me of a dream from just before we bought the House of Divine Grace in 2007: I was on a plane going so fast it looked like it would crash. Yet we landed safely at the House of Divine Grace. And God said to me: "My speed makes you uncomfortable, but it brings Me glory and fulfills My purpose." So if you are feeling this unsettling acceleration now in your life, know: It may be God's hand preparing you for destiny.

I see the coming **Hour of Encounter prayer conference**, how God will be helping people by giving them **divine acceleration**, more especially in the **seven mountains of society**.

I see how God will help us in the Kingdom Business Conference of the first two days to receive spiritual tools that will help us to be in God's speed and to see God's hand upon our lives.

God is calling us to **spiritually prepare ourselves** in this season through **obedience and readiness to move when He speaks** prophetically, because He will grant us speed like never before.

Take note, **God's speed** is not just sudden speed, but **sustained strength to finish the assignment** that He has given to us very well.

God's speed is also a way God announces a season of revival because God is granting us **acceleration** not only **for personal blessing** but **also to advance His kingdom**, announce His reign and fulfill His prophetic mandate.

Take note, as the Lord has already told us in August:

This season, we are going to **be more and more prepared towards the coming winter**. God will prepare us to stand strong and to continue to **fight every spirit of depression** that the enemy is bringing into our world in this year 2025.
